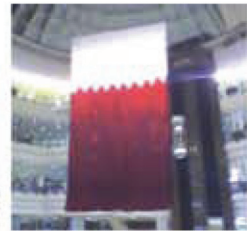

Japanese funds, technology to fire India's Rs 60,000 crore bullet-train dream

NEW DELHI: With Japan committing to fund bullet trains, the dream of running high-speed trains on Indian tracks is now a step closer.

PM Narendra Modi's dream project got a big push after Japan expressed readiness to provide financial, technical and operational support to introduce bullet trains in India in a joint statement.

The first high-speed train is expected to run

between Ahmedabad and Mumbai at an estimated cost of around Rs 60,000-70,000 crores.

As Japan is a pioneer in running superfast trains, the agreement is expected to help Modi achieve his dream of a bullet train for India running at a maximum of 300 km per hour.

"Lauding PM Modi's vision for development of world class infrastructure in India, including

Obama condemns 'senseless' murder of Israeli teens

WASHINGTON: US president Barack Obama condemned Monday the "senseless" murder of three Israeli teenagers and warned against actions that could further "destabilize" the situation, amid threats of retaliation against Hamas.

"The United States condemns in the strongest

possible terms this senseless act of terror against innocent youth," Obama said in a written statement.

The president expressed "deepest and heartfelt condolences" to the families of Eyal Yifrach, Gilad Shaar and Naftali Fraenkel, who was a dual Israeli-American citizen.

ISIS Video Shows Beheading of American Journalist Steven Sotloff



A video posted online Tuesday purportedly shows Sotloff, dressed in an orange jumpsuit, being executed by a masked ISIS member clad in black.

The family of Sotloff made a statement via a spokesman that they believe the video of his beheading to be authentic.

"The family knows of this horrific tragedy and is grieving privately. There will be no public comment from the family during this difficult time," stated the spokesman.

For its part, the White House and the State Department have not officially confirmed the authenticity of the online video.

Concentrated in Northern Iraq and Syria, ISIS was created last year from the al Qaeda affiliate, al Qaeda in Iraq.

Over the past few months it has garnered a reputation for violence and atrocity, as well as condemnations from many Muslim leaders across the Islamic world.

Freelance journalist Steven Sotloff is seen in a video released by SITE Intelligence Group, which shows an ISIS terrorist beheading the American in a warning to the Obama administration. The State Department said Tuesday, Sept. 2, 2014, that it has yet to

confirm the authenticity of the video, which the Islamic State is calling the "Second Warning to America."

The Islamic State has beheaded Steven J. Sotloff, an American journalist held hostage by the terrorist organization.

Top Muslim Leaders Across Globe Find ISIS Extremist to Be Corrupt and a Danger to Islam

The insurgent group Islamic State of Iraq and Levant (ISIL) or ISIS is not only viewed by the US Government and most Christians as a terrible organization, but it is also drawing strong ill will from people within the Muslim community. Yesterday, Egypt's top religious authority condemned the armed group which has forcibly



taken over large parts of Iraq and Syria and committed terrible crimes and atrocities along the way. "An extremist and

bloody group such as this poses a danger to Islam and Muslims, tarnishing its image as well as shedding blood and spreading corruption," said Grand Mufti Shawqi Allam, Egypt's most influential Muslim cleric, the state news agency MENA reported. He describing the group as a corrupt, extremist organization that is dam-

aging Islam. Allam's view represents the opinion of Al-Azhar, one of the world's oldest seats of Muslim learning, which influences the opinions of Muslims worldwide, and came as the Vatican called on Muslim religious leaders to take a "clear and courageous stance" and condemn the "unspeakable crimi-

20,000 Yazidis, Christians Saved, Dozens of ISIS Militants Killed by U.S. Military

Tens of thousands of Yazidis and Christians have been saved as U.S. forces continue to attack ISIS targets in Iraq Saturday, and Kurdish forces, who control the northern region where the militants are being fought, say American military is "crucial" to defeating the terrorist group. On Sunday, the U.S. military carried out a new wave of airstrikes against militant targets in Iraq, successfully striking five targets within five hours. According to Iraqi officials, airstrikes Saturday killed 16 ISIS fighters, and an Iraqi airstrike in Sinjar killed an additional 45 ISIS fighters, Iraq state media reported. Airstrikes also targeted Islamic militants near the town of Makhmur near Ar-



bil, the capital of the semi-autonomous Kurdish region in northern Iraq and home to

a U.S. consulate and U.S.-Iraqi joint military operations center.

20,000 Yazidis, Christians Saved...

According to CNN, a rescue effort Sunday has freed 20,000 of the Yazidi refugees trapped in the Sinjar mountains in northern Iraq and surrounded by ISIS forces. However, thousands remain stranded with limited food and water

supplies. Most of the women taken captive by ISIS are below the age of 35 and are being held in schools in the city of Mosul. About 50,000 other Yazidis, half of them children and who were earlier forced to flee to the north-west region

with death threats, also remain trapped in Sinjar. Some Iraqi Yazidis Refugees Survive Mt. Sinjar Exodus After US Airstrikes On Sunday, Iraqi Ministry of Human Rights spokesman Kamil Amin said it was possible that as many

as 500 Yazidis had been killed. The ministry had also heard reports that some had possibly been buried alive. The U.S. military made a fourth airdrop of food and water to Iraqis stranded on Mount Sinjar on Sunday night, according to U.S. Central Command.

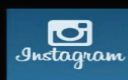

Chinese Government Wants To Control, Nationalize Christian Theology

The Chinese government continues to impose restrictions of religious freedoms within the country, most recently announcing it will make every effort to nationalize Christianity. "The construction of Chinese Christian theology should adapt to China's national condition and integrate with Chinese culture," Chinese state media quoted Wang Zuoan, director of the State Administration for Religious Affairs. The move "will provide theological guidance for church rostrums in China and will promote the positive and correct theological thinking with



a range of publications, exchanges, discussions and evangelism," reports the China Daily according to the Associated Press. "This will encourage more believers to make contributions to the country's harmonious social prog-

ress, cultural prosperity and economic development," explained Gu Mengfei, deputy secretary-general of the Three-Self Patriotic Movement - a state-sanctioned umbrella organization for Protestant churches

ISIS Video Shows Beheading of American Journalist ...

State Department spokeswoman Jen Psaki said that the government will work as quickly as possible to verify the video's authenticity.

"The intelligence community will work as quickly as possible to determine its authenticity. If the video is genuine, we are sickened by this brutal act taking the life of another innocent American citizen. Our hearts go out to the Sotloff family," stated Psaki.

The killing of Sotloff comes two weeks after ISIS beheaded another American journalist, James Foley, placing the footage online as with the latest video.

Both killings were done by ISIS in response to the United States launching airstrikes against the terrorist group in an effort to stop the organization from attacking religious minorities and Americans in Iraq.

nal acts" being charged against the group.

Egyptian media reports said Allam also expressed his objection to the "widespread error" in referring to the group as "the Islamic State," its new name, because, according to Allam, it violates both long-established principles of Shariah and the contemporary founda-

tions of humanitarian law, according to the Lebanon Daily Star. The ISIL has declared a Muslim caliphate in the territory it has captured in Iraq and Syria, and named Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi as the Caliph, or political successor to Muhammad. According to the BBC, al-Baghdadi is a mysterious figure, but it is believed he was

born in Samarra, north of Baghdad, in 1971 and found his start in the insurgency that erupted in Iraq soon after the 2003 US-led invasion. In 2010 he emerged as a top battlefield commander for al-Qaeda in Iraq, one of the groups that later became ISIL. Since then, even Al-Qaeda has distanced itself from the ISIL. It sees

all Shi'ite Muslims, Christians, Yazidis, or any other religious group that do not strictly line up with hard line Sunni teachings as Heretics, and brags about killing people. The group is known for burying people alive, torturing them, and also taking women and Children as slaves, if they don't rape, and kill them first.

A PANHANDLERS PLEA!

A 19-year-old woman stands at an intersection corner in Oklahoma City with a sign in her hand declaring one phrase; "I am too ugly to prostitute". Some notice her, some don't. Some look on her to ascertain whether or not she is that ugly. Soon the signals turns to green and people pass her with self-pity and a negative attitude. When my friend Sujith Mathew Jacob, a social worker, shared this heartfelt story, I almost cried.

When my friend stopped at the red signal, he noticed this young woman, who was trying to find somebody to help her survive. She was broken. She looks weary, depressed and hopeless with low self-esteem. She was just trying to survive that day. Her life was almost stuck in that intercession. She does not know about her self-worth and inner beauty. She has lost herself and has forgotten how valuable and precious she is in sight of God. Nobody knows who she is; her identity to the public as an ugly, poor woman, because that is how she portrays herself.

Often, people feel insecure and struggle with their value and identity when they fall. Many of us have wandered in an intersection of life with too much confusion. Once we fail in life, there are chances to take the wrong way unless somebody comes and intervenes in our life. It's easy for all of us to fall and lose direction in life at some point. Countless times, we are stuck at one

point or wait too long to get a different direction in life. Sometimes our lives goes according to plan and other times our dreams are shattered. It's so hard to respond to questions about self-identity and self-value at the downfall of life.

Two things I wanted to narrate here are our self-worth and identity and the community responsibility of coming out from the conventional to reach out to these downtrodden and help them find their value in life. We rush to judge and condemn these people, which only adds more pain to their wounds.

Every person has a chance to take the right direction; however, some don't take these opportunities and only realize their bad choices later in life. Some people struggle to leave the old ways behind.

It reminds me a story in the Bible about a Good Samaritan. A Jewish traveler is robbed and beaten on a journey and left to die on the side of the road. A priest walks by him but does not stop to help; a Pharisee also sees him, yet does not have compassion. Finally a Samaritan, usually despised by Jews, does stop and help the man, even taking him to an inn and paying for him to receive care. This story shows us how to be a good example to our neighbors.

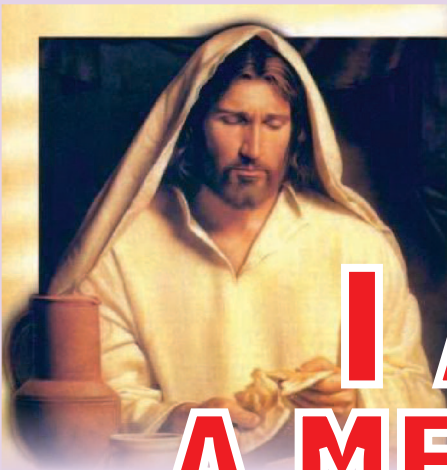
Many times we are reluctant in life to help people who are fallen or accept

them. Every individual has a story and every story is unique. We are often stunted in an act of kindness and action.

My friend went home and drove back to the same intersection with his wife after an hour. The woman still stands there with the signpost. She looks tired and has fear in her eyes. They stepped out of the car and invited her to dinner. She was relished with that invitation and her face moves with joy. After dinner, they took her to a motel where she was able to bathe and sleep soundly. They offered help to take her to a rescue mission where she could get a new start. She was reluctant to go. But the next morning, my friend received a phone call from her. She thanked him and asked him to take her to the rescue mission so she could start a new life.

She ceased to be a panhandler since that day. She identified her beauty, self worth and a realistic appraisal on herself so that she could say, "I have some good qualities, I am no longer rejected; I am a person of worth and value and I can take the way of making better choices in life." How many of us can persuade others to understand their self worth and value when they cross our paths?

Not all of us are storytellers, but we definitely can rewrite the stories of others we see in our life journey with a little kindness and action.



I AM A MESSAGE

"You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, known and read by everybody. You show that you are letter from Christ, the result of our ministry, written not with ink but with the spirit of the Living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts," 2 Cor. 3:2-3

Living transformed lives is a testimony of God's power and grace. Many of us have heard people share their amazing life stories of how they met Jesus, and some of us may in turn have come to know Jesus ourselves through hearing that story. For Apostle Paul, there is no doubt that he and the other early workers in the church had hard times, which would have caused discouragement. To hear about and see the work of Jesus in the people at the church at Corinth was a message of hope for Paul, as it displayed the evidence of God working in their lives. We can also make sure we are ready to tell people about Jesus, and part of that can include displaying what we believe. For us this is where I AM A MESSAGE comes in.

There is an old saying and it goes something like this: you are the only Bible unbelievers read. Just as our lives can display a good message about our faith, they can also display a negative message. As a Christian, it is important that we take time to reflect on our words, attitudes and actions regularly and ask ourselves what kind of message we send out to our unsaved friends and families. Spicy Beef Fry



Marie Thomas

Ingredients:-

To make the Meat masala powder

Bowl -1 Roast and Grind
Kashmiri Chili powder 2 tablespoon
Coriander seeds - 4 tablespoon
Black Peppercorns - 1 teaspoon
Cinnamon - 2 small sticks
Cardamom - 5
Cloves - 6
Star anise - 2
Bay leaves - 1
Fennel seeds - 1/2 teaspoon
Turmeric powder - 1/2 teaspoon

To pressure cook

Beef - 1 kg
Salt to taste
Masala powder - half of the recipe above

To Simmer and roast

Shallots chopped - 1 cup
Garlic chopped - 4-5 cloves
Ginger chopped - a small piece
Green chili chopped - 3
Coconut cuts - 1/4 cup
Salt to taste
Curry Leaves
Oil



Method:-

Heat a small pan and add all the ingredients in the section to make meat masala powder, except turmeric powder. Dry roast it for 4-5 minutes on a medium steady flame, until aromatic and brown. Switch off the heat and add turmeric powder. Grind it to a coarse powder in a coffee grinder. This will give you about 5-6 tablespoon of meat masala. Clean and cut the beef into medium cubes and marinate it with half of the prepared masala powder (around 2.5 - 3 table spoon), salt to taste and curry leaves. Pressure-cook it for 3-4 whistles. Heat oil in a heavy bottomed cooking pan and add curry leaves and coconut cuts. Fry for 3-4 minutes and add onion. Saute for 7-8 minutes; add crushed ginger, garlic and green chilies. Saute till they start to turn brown. Add the remaining masala powder and fry for a minute or two. Add the cooked beef along with cooking liquid if any and simmer until it is dry.

Turn the flame to medium and saute, stirring often and scrape the bottom of the pan to prevent from sticking, until it turns dark and dry. Serve warm

I also gave them this command: Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people. Do all that I command so that good things will happen to you.
